PRESIDENTS MESSAGE

On behalf of all of us who were elected/re-elected at last month's meeting, thank you for your support! We look forward to serving our Club to the best of our abilities over the next year. In fact, your new Board has already started work on next year's program and other significant actions. A summary of key actions taken by your new board include:

-Maintain our membership fee of \$20 per year for current and new members who join between now and March, 2004. After March, the fee for new members only, will decrease by \$5 for the following two quarters. In other words, those joining April-June will pay \$15, those joining July-September will pay \$10. Anyone joining October-December will pay \$20 and be a member thru December of the following year. We believe this will help attract and be more fair to those new members who join later in the year. Remember, this graduated scale is for NEW MEMBERS ONLY. Dues (renewals) will be \$20 per year thereafter. Roni Elsberry, our new Membership Chair, and Ray Brooks will be selling memberships at our meeting in September.

-Membership Drive for 2004-In order for our Club to survive both financially and as a long term entity we need to increase our membership. Our goal is to double our membership from the current 54 to 100 in 2004. To do that, we are launching an "Every Member Get A New Member" campaign. We will be asking you to bring in a friend, relative, neighbor, whomever (?), as a new member over the next few months—preferably by March 2004!! We also plan to increase our "advertising" through various media and develop a membership brochure.

-Increase our interaction with other woodworking clubs. We believe there are synergies to be realized by working more closely with other clubs such as woodturners, woodcarvers, scrollers, etc. where we can share expertise (guest speakers, demos etc.), perhaps have joint meetings, and participate in joint projects. We will need to develop this idea and would very much like your thoughts.

Thanks much to all who contributed items to our display in Jocelyn Center. It looks terrific!! For those of you who may not have a chance to stop by the display, I will have some photos available by our next meeting.

I understand Steve Alwardt gave a great marquetry presentation at our August meeting! Sorry I could not be there but family duties had me up in the northwest!! Thanks, Steve, for sharing your talents and skills with us!!
