### **Modification of club by laws**

This is notice of the intent to change club by laws at the August 17th, 2006 general meeting of the North County Woodworking Club.

The by law change to be voted on is as follows:

#### **Article VII, Section 6**

**Part F) Terms of office for all elected positions shall be for one calendar year, beginning in the month following the election or, in the event of a vacancy, until the end of the current election period. That is, officers shall be elected for the period August through July. Elected officials may serve up to two consecutive years in their respective positions. Thereafter they may serve in a new position or be voted off the board for at least one year prior to running for other elective office.**

The new by law will read as follows:

#### **Article VII, Section 6**

**Part F) Terms of office for all elected positions shall be for one calendar year, beginning in the month following the election or, in the event of a vacancy, until the end of the current election period. That is, officers shall be elected for the period August through July. Officers may be reelected.**
